Spring, a modular sofa designed by <a href="Patricia">Patricia</a>
<a href="Urquiola">Urquiola</a>, is the third chapter in a corporate and design process which Moroso started with the Springfield sofa in 2002.

Springfield is a sofa concept which, from an idea of close yet separate solid geometric shapes led to a large, comfortable and stylish basic sofa with a strong visual and design impact.

In 2008, Field marked a revision of the original design. The modules were made independent and, with padded fabric, more comfortable. The special sewing on the corners added a further ornamental touch.

Accessible to those wanting a product whose design, materials and brand are all of proven quality; an unprecedented solution for those looking for smart, certified eco-friendly products

In 2010 Spring came full circle.

Modular seating, characterised by very simple, geometric shapes, that can be arranged in many different ways. With completely removable covers, like the previous designs it displays a meticulous eye for details and the high quality of its component materials. A first among Moroso products, Spring uses organic cotton, a certified eco-friendly fibre for producing higher range fabrics.

A new solution in keeping with the needs of modern living.

### Organic cotton, a responsible choice

Cotton-growing takes up 3% of the world's farmed areas but it requires 18% of all the chemicals used in agriculture. By virtue of crop rotation and the avoidance of environmentally damaging pesticides and fertilisers, organic farming preserves the soil's fertility so it can be farmed long-term.



## <u>Low-environmental-</u> <u>impact padding</u>

Spring is padded
with a new-generation microcellular foam
made from a compound derived
from renewable plant sources, polyols,
not from petroleum by-products.
It is eco-friendly, certified
by Oeko-Tex as free of harmful
substances and any ozone-damaging
substances were eliminated
from its production process.



# Compact and suitable for apartments or waiting rooms

Spring provides all the comfort of a larger sofa despite the compact size of its individual units. The excellent finishes and soft padding do not spoil the sofa's streamlined silhouette. Extremely pleasant to the touch, the organic cotton is not bleached or dyed with harsh chemical substances.



# A choice for eco-friendly, sustainable textiles and materials

Spring is the answer to the need and desire for products that satisfy today's market demands without spoiling the chance of future generations to satisfy their needs. The sofa has a wooden frame covered in a new high-quality eco-foam which is very elastic, breathable and durable. The modules are upholstered in certified organic fabric. No synthetic chemicals were used in growing, harvesting or processing the cotton and no harmful substances were used to bleach and soften the fibres but only natural products.



#### **SPRING**

The Spring seating range's modular units have a wooden frame covered with "Lympha" microcellular foam made from vegetable oils and polyester fibre. Lympha foams are exceptionally breathable, ensuring a good air flow and thus inhibiting mould, dust mites and bacteria. This high-quality foam is chemical-free. Feet made of polypropylene. The optional backrest cushions are padded with goose feather. Spring has fully removable covers.

#### CARE AND USE

The Spring modular sofa is intended solely for indoor use. Do not stand on the seats or sit or jump on the back and armrests as this may cause breakage. When moving the seating for any distance whatsoever, do not drag it along the floor: lift it instead to avoid damage to the frame and to the floor itself. Protect the parts that touch the floor from knocks and contact with water or cleaning products containing corrosive chemicals. The seat and arms can be simply taken apart and reassembled for easier cleaning. For routine cleaning, brush the seating regularly with a soft brush and, if needed, gently wipe the fabric with a damp cloth. The goose-feather cushions should be plumped frequently to

make them softer and help them keep their shape over time. Every type of fabric or leather has specific qualities: for nonroutine care follow the instructions given in the warranty.

#### DISPOSAL

At product end of life, separate upholstery and structural parts as much as possible to facilitate recycling and disposal operations. Most of the materials used for manufacturing Moroso products can be recycled. Arrangements should be made with local waste management and recycling services for disposal, making sure that the procedures implemented comply with current legislation in the




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
